- Advertisements can be submitted in full or spot color, but will be converted to the publication color before printing
- The deadlines for submitting advertising art work in the newsletter are: February 1, May 1, August 1, and December 1 of each year. Conference program advertising deadline is June 15.
- All advertising payments must be received within 7 calendar days of artwork deadline.

- PDF files must have fonts and images embedded
